SUPPLEMENTARY MEDICAL PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 359)

ORDER MADE BY THE OPTOMETRISTS BOARD

It is hereby notified that the Optometrists Board, after due inquiry held on 8 June 2005 in accordance with the Optometrists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Chapter 359, subsidiary legislation), was satisfied that Mr. TSE Kwok-chiu, being a registered optometrist, had been guilty in Hong Kong of unprofessional conduct in that:—

- (a) on or about 15 January 2004 at your shop at Ground Floor, 7 Sai Yeung Choi Street, Mongkok, Kowloon ('the Shop') prescribed and dispensed a pair of spectacles and 3 pairs of contact lenses to Ms. LAI Ka-yee, Karen, which prescriptions were not appropriate to her eyes conditions; and
- (b) on or about 26 January 2004 failed to give proper explanation or appropriate action to Ms. LAI Ka-yee, Karen when she visited you at the Shop and complained to you about the visual problems for wearing the spectacles and contact lenses prescribed by you.

In accordance with section 22(1)(ii) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance, the Optometrists Board ordered on 8 June 2005 that Mr. TSE Kwok-chiu's name should be removed from the register of optometrists for three months and such order shall be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
