## MEDICAL REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 161)

## ORDER MADE BY THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that the Medical Council of Hong Kong after due inquiry held on 28 January 2010 in accordance with section 21 of the Medical Registration Ordinance, Chapter 161 of the Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied that in or around June 2006, Dr. WONG Ka Yan Fiona, being a registered medical practitioner, promoted, or acquiesced in the promotion of, or failed to take adequate steps to prevent the promotion of her practice in association with an organization known as 'the Skin Clinic' by means of the inclusion in an advertisement in the 7 June 2006 issue of the publication 'Sunday Life' of a coupon offering advantages to new clients.

The Council was satisfied that in relation to the facts alleged, Dr. WONG has been guilty of misconduct in a professional respect.

In accordance with section 21(1)(iii) of the Medical Registration Ordinance, the Council ordered on 28 January 2010 that Dr. WONG Ka Yan Fiona be reprimanded.

In accordance with section 21(5) of the Medical Registration Ordinance, the order shall be published in The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
