LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE (Chapter 159)

ORDER THAT A SOLICITOR BE SUSPENDED FROM PRACTISING
JONATHAN EDWARD SPENCER ROSTRON

In accordance with section 12(2) of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Chapter 159), I hereby give notice that on 29 August 2011 a Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal found a complaint for 2 charges against Mr. Jonathan Edward Spencer ROSTRON proved. The proven complaint was that Mr. ROSTRON acted in breach of Rule 10 and 11 of the Solicitors' Accounts Rules.

The Tribunal ordered that:—

- (a) Mr. ROSTRON be fined HK\$50,000.00;
- (b) Mr. ROSTRON be suspended for a period of three years and be subject to the condition to practice that on his resuming practice as a solicitor, for the first three years, he cannot do so as a sole-proprietor or partner of any solicitors firm and can only do so as an employed solicitor under the supervision of a solicitor of no less than ten years' active post-qualification experience in Hong Kong; and
- (c) Half of the costs of these proceedings, including the costs of the Clerk, be borne and paid by Mr. ROSTRON, such costs to be taxed, if not agreed, on a party-and-party basis.

The Order of the Tribunal dated 29 August 2011 was filed with me on 30 August 2011.
