

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in triplicate are invited for **Contract No. 2180EM17T, 50-month Term Contract for the Comprehensive Maintenance and Repair of Lift Installations at Various Premises of the Hospital Authority (TO17)**. The scope of Works includes the maintenance and repair of lift installations in various premises of the Hospital Authority. The Contract is scheduled to commence in April 2018 for expiration in June 2022.
