

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN YAU ON STREET AND
LOWER SHING MUN ROAD, TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 10 January 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Yau On Street from its junction with Lower Shing Mun Road to a point about 95 metres south of the same junction (except lay-by); and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Lower Shing Mun Road from its junction with Yau On Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
