Decision on Disciplinary Power Exercised

- 1. In respect of the aforesaid matter (i):—
 - (a) The licensee is reprimanded;
 - (b) The licensee is fined HK\$2,000; and
 - (c) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.
- 2. In respect of the aforesaid matter (ii):—
 - (a) The licensee is reprimanded;
 - (b) The licensee is fined HK\$2,000; and
 - (c) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.

With regard to paragraphs 1(c) and 2(c) above, the condition being attached to the licence concerned of the licensee is as follows:—

'The above-named licensee shall, during the period of 24 months from 12 December 2022 to 11 December 2024, attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 24 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority, and at least 6 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.'
