

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN YEE KUK STREET AND
YEN CHOW STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 11 January 2023 to 10.00 a.m. on 13 January 2023, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Yee Kuk Street from a point about 33 metres west of its junction with Yen Chow Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Yee Kuk Street from its junction with Yen Chow Street to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Yen Chow Street southbound from a point about 48 metres north of its junction with Yee Kuk Street to a point about 12 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be temporarily rescinded.
