ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON HANG MING STREET AND HANG KIN STREET, MA ON SHAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 January 2023, the following sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Hang Ming Street northbound from a point about 25 metres south of its junction with Hang Kin Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Hang Ming Street southbound from a point about 60 metres north of its junction with Hang Kin Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of Hang Kin Street from its junction with Hang Ming Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
