ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT TAI CHUNG KIU ROAD AND SHA TIN ROAD, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 March 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Chung Kiu Road from its junction with Sha Tin Road to a point about 65 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of slip road of Sha Tin Road from its junction with Tai Chung Kiu Road to a point about 37 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Sha Tin Road from its junction with Tai Chung Kiu Road to a point about 18 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Sha Tin Road from a point about 6 metres south with Tai Chung Kiu Road to a point about 41 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
