ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 21 March 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 31 August 2022, the following road sections in Yuen Long will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Ping Shun Street from it junction with the unnamed access road connecting Ping Shun Street and Ma Wang Road to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the section of the unnamed access road connecting Ping Shun Street and Ma Wang Road from its junction with Ping Shun Street to a point about 60 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of the unnamed access road connecting Ping Shun Street and Ma Wang Road from a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Ma Wang Road to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Chun Yin Square from a point about 15 metres south from its junction with Ma Wang Road to a point about 80 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Chun Yin Square from a point about 25 metres south from its junction with Ma Wang Road to a point about 70 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the temporary restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
