ESTATE AGENTS ORDINANCE (Chapter 511)

Pursuant to section 30 of the Estate Agents Ordinance, it is hereby notified that the Disciplinary Committee of Estate Agents Authority has exercised the following disciplinary power against the following licensee:—

<i>Licence No.</i>	S-560878
<i>Name of Licensee</i>	LI Tiantian
<i>Matter Concerned</i>	The licensee failed to specify in a provisional agreement for sale and purchase the commission payable by the vendor and/or the total amount of commission payable by the purchaser in the event of her default before arranging for the purchaser to sign the same.
<i>Date of Decision</i>	5 February 2024
<i>Decision on Disciplinary Power Exercised</i>	(a) Reprimand; and (b) The following condition be attached to the licence concerned of the licensee:— ‘The above-named licensee shall, during the period of 12 months from 26 February 2024 to 25 February 2025, attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme ‘Compliance and Effective Management’ category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.’
