

## PUBLIC ORDER ORDINANCE (Chapter 245)

## FRONTIER CLOSED AREA—PERMISSION TO ENTER

Pursuant to section 38A(1) of the Public Order Ordinance and without prejudice to the provisions of any other Ordinance, persons within the category specified in the second column of the below Schedule, are permitted to enter or leave the Frontier Closed Area, i.e. (i) a section of Lo Wu Station Road linking to Lo Wu Railway Station and Sandy Ridge Cemetery; and (ii) the footbridge linking Tak Yuet Lau and Lo Wu Railway Station, during the dates and times specified in the third column of the Schedule, subject to the conditions specified in the fourth column of the Schedule.

In this notice, 'the Frontier Closed Area' refers to the area specified in the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area Order.

1	Persons wishing to worship at the family graves inside the Sandy Ridge Cemetery, Lo Wu.	Between 06.00 hours and 18.00 hours each day from 23 March 2024 (Saturday) to 21 April 2024 (Sunday)	(a) Persons must be <i>bona-fide</i> worshippers; (b) Persons must proceed by the most direct route to and from the Cemetery; and (c) Entry or exit is permitted only <i>via</i> the railway station at Lo Wu or the footbridge leading to Tak Yuet Lau.
