

LANDS RESUMPTION ORDINANCE (Chapter 124)
(Notice under section 4)

RESUMPTION OF LAND FOR
THE DEVELOPMENT OF PUBLIC HOUSING AND A PUBLIC SECTOR SCHOOL
AT CHUNG NGA ROAD WEST, TAI PO

To the owners and every person interested or having any right or easement in all those pieces or parcels of land in the New Territories more particularly described below and shown coloured orange on the Resumption Plan No. TPM6559:—

Lots Nos. 1088 RP, 1097, 1415, 1417 RP, 1481 RP, 1485 RP, 1503, 1504 and 1509 (Portion) all in Demarcation District No. 11.

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive in Council has decided that the above-mentioned land is required for a public purpose, and under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, I have made an order that the above-mentioned land shall be resumed and revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region on the expiration of THREE MONTHS from the date of the affixing of this notice to the said land.

This notice was affixed to the above-mentioned land on 23 March 2023. Upon expiration of the notice period at midnight on 23 June 2023, the above-mentioned land shall revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. The date of reversion shall be 24 June 2023.
