

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 8(2))

ROAD WORKS UNDER PWP ITEM NO. 7849CL
SITE FORMATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR
PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AT CHA KWO LING VILLAGE,
KOWLOON EAST

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60672654/GAZ/100 to 60672654/GAZ/104 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of a carriageway with associated footpaths, amenity areas, central reserves/refuge islands, pedestrian crossings and vehicular run-ins/run-outs connecting the access road of the planned housing development at ex-Cha Kwo Ling Kaolin Mine Site and Cha Kwo Ling Road;
- (ii) construction of a footbridge linking (i) and the planned development of Cha Kwo Ling Village;
- (iii) construction of a carriageway with associated footpaths, amenity areas, pedestrian crossings, vehicular run-in/run-out and staircase connecting Cha Kwo Ling Road and Fan Wa Street;
- (iv) construction of carriageways, footpath and pedestrian crossings at Cha Kwo Ling Road and construction of footpaths and pedestrian crossings at Sin Fat Road;
- (v) modification and reconstruction of the existing Wing Fook Street, and Fan Wa Street, as well as sections of the existing Cha Kwo Ling Road, Wai Yip Street and Sin Fat Road;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central reserves/refuge islands into carriageways;
- (vii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways and amenity areas;
- (viii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, amenity area and central reserves/refuge islands;
- (ix) permanent closure and conversion of the existing staircase into footpath, carriageway and amenity area;
- (x) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing footpaths, carriageways, central reserves/refuge islands and staircase; and
- (xi) ancillary works including electrical and mechanical, site formation, slope stabilization, drainage, sewage, water mains, utilities, lighting and landscaping works, as well as construction of retaining wall and slopes.

The objector should describe his interest and the manner in which he alleges that he will be affected by the works or the use in his notice of objection. Objectors are requested to provide contact details to facilitate communication. A notice of objection should be delivered to the Secretary for Transport and Housing not later than the 24th day of May 2022.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written objections/comments will be used for the processing of the objections/comments and other related purposes. The provision of any information, including the personal data, other than the information as required under section 10(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is voluntary. However, it may not be possible to process the objections/comments if such information, including the personal data, is not sufficiently provided. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies which are required to handle the objections/comments and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us. Request for access to or correction of the personal data should be made in writing to the Personal Data Privacy Officer of the Transport and Housing Bureau (Transport Branch) at 20th Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong.
