

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT TAI CHUNG KIU ROAD AND
YUEN CHAU KOK ROAD, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 1 April 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Chung Kiu Road from a point about 49 metres east of its junction with Yuen Chau Kok Road to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Yuen Chau Kok Road from its junction with Tai Chung Kiu Road to a point about 14 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Yuen Chau Kok Road from its junction with Tai Chung Kiu Road to a point about 44 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
