

## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 22 April 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) The eastern kerbside lane of Fu Tin Lane from its junction with Tin Sam Street to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) The northern kerbside lane of Tin Sam Street from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Fu Tin Lane to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) The section of Fu Kin Street from its junction with Hin Keng Street to a point about 75 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) The eastern kerbside lane of Fu Kin Street from its junction with Hin Keng Street to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) The western kerbside lane of Fu Kin Street from its junction with Hin Keng Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (f) The southern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from its junction with Fu Kin Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (g) The northern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from its junction with Fu Kin Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (h) The northern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from a point about 35 metres west of its junction with Hin Wo Lane to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction (except lay-by); and
- (i) The eastern kerbside lane of Hin Wo Lane from its junction with Hin Keng Street to a point about 40 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
