ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 April 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Chik Fuk Road from a point about 110 metres south of its junction with Chik Shun Street to a point about 135 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Shing Ho Road from a point about 75 metres south of its junction with Chik Shun Street to a point about 135 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of the unnamed road leading from Tin Sum Street to MTR Tai Wai Depot from a point about 8 metres north of its junction with Tin Sum Street to a point about 13 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of the unnamed road leading from MTR Tai Wai Depot to Tin Sum Street from a point about 3 metres north of its junction with Tin Sum Street to a point about 8 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
