ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON ON MUK STREET AND ON SUM STREET, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 14 April 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of On Muk Street from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with On Sum Street to a point about 65 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of On Muk Street from a point about 5 metres west of its junction with On Sum Street to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of On Sum Street from its junction with On Muk Street to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
