

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KING YING LANE, TSEUNG KWAN O

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 22 April 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of the unnamed access road leading to Po Lam Road North from its junction with King Yin Lane to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of the unnamed access road leading to Po Lam Road North from its junction with King Yin Lane to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the eastern kerbside lane of Po Lam Road North from a point about 5 metres north of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Po Lam Road North to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction will be rescinded.
