Notes:

1. A proprietor who fails to comply with this notice commits an offence under section 10(1A) of the Factories and Industrial Undertakings Ordinance and is liable to a fine of \$400,000 and to imprisonment for 6 months.
2. Under section 9A(4), a proprietor who is aggrieved by the issue of this notice may within 28 days appeal against it to the Administrative Appeals Board.
3. Under section 9A(3), the Commissioner for Labour may, and if so requested by the proprietor shall, cancel this notice if he is satisfied that the matter leading to the issue of the notice has been remedied.
