ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 April 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of On Po Lane from its junction with On Po Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of On Po Road (including the lay-by) from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with On Po Lane to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of On Po Road from its junction with On Po Lane to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of the westbound carriageway of Ting Kok Road between the northbound carriageway of On Po Road and the southbound carriageway of On Po Road;
- (e) the western kerbside lane of the northbound carriageway of On Po Road between Ting Kok Road and On Po Road roundabout;
- (f) the section of the access road leading to Yee Nga Court from its junction with On Po Road to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (g) the eastern kerbside lane of the northbound carriageway of On Po Road from its junction with Ting Kok Road to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction;
- (h) the eastern kerbside lane of the southbound carriageway of On Po Road from its junction with Ting Kok Road to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction;
- (i) the western kerbside lane of the southbound carriageway of On Po Road from its junction with Ting Kok Road to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (j) the eastern kerbside lane of the southbound carriageway of On Po Road from its junction with On Po Road roundabout to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
