ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHEUNG SHUL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 April 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Lung Sum Avenue northbound from a point about 65 metres south of its junction with San Hong Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction:
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Lung Sum Avenue southbound from a point about 25 metres north of its junction with Chi Cheong Road to a point about 50 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the section of San Hong Street from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of Chi Cheong Road from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
