ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON TATE'S CAIRN HIGHWAY AND SHA LEK HIGHWAY. SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that the following road sections will be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour during the following periods:—

Implementation Period

- (i) from 8.00 p.m. on 6 May 2022 to 3.00 p.m. on 10 May 2022; and
- (ii) from 8.00 p.m. on 13 May 2022 to 3.00 p.m. on 16 May 2022
- (i) from 10.00 a.m. on 6 May 2022 to 5.00 a.m. (a) the section of Tate's Cairn Highway on 10 May 2022; and southbound from a point about
- (ii) from 10.00 a.m. on 13 May 2022 to 5.00 a.m. on 16 May 2022

Road Section

- (a) the section of Tate's Cairn Highway northbound from a point about 50 metres north of Ngau Pei Sha Street to a point about 150 metres north of On Hing Lane; and
- (b) the section of Sha Lek Highway northbound from a point about 350 metres west of Ngan Shing Street to its junction with Tate's Cairn Highway.
- (a) the section of Tate's Cairn Highway southbound from a point about 500 metres north of its junction with Shek Mun Interchange to a point about 100 metres south of On Hing Lane.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
