

ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON TATE'S CAIRN HIGHWAY
AND SHA LEK HIGHWAY, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. of the following day daily from Mondays to Fridays during the period on 12 May 2022, from 17 May 2022 to 27 May 2022 and from 13 June 2022 to 30 June 2022, the following section of Tate's Cairn Highway will be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of Tate's Cairn Highway southbound from a point about 50 metres north of its junction with Sha Lek Highway to a point about 150 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Sha Lek Highway southbound from its junction with Tate's Cairn Highway to a point about 150 metres south of Ngau Pei Sha Street.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour on the above road section will be temporarily rescinded.
