

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON
YU CHAU WEST STREET AND KING LAM STREET, LAI CHI KOK

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 5 May 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 2 June 2023, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Yu Chau West Street from its junction with King Lam Street to a point about 12 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Yu Chau West Street from its junction with King Lam Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of King Lam Street from its junction with Yu Chau West Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
