

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON SZE SHAN STREET, CHO YUEN STREET AND
SHUNG SHAN STREET, YAU TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 13 May 2022, the following road sections in Yau Tong will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside of Sze Shan Street from a point about 25 metres west of its southern junction with Cho Yuen Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside of Cho Yuen Street from its southern junction with Sze Shan Street to a point about 80 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside of Cho Yuen Street from its southern junction with Sze Shan Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of Shung Shan Street from its junction with Cho Yuen Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
