

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 5.30 a.m. on 14 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Hung Hing Road from a point about 10 metres west of its junction with Marsh Road to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Hung Hing Road from its junction with Tonnochy Road to a point about 50 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tonnochy Road from its junction with Hung Hing Road to a point about 40 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the unnamed road connecting Convention Avenue westbound and Fleming Road southbound.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
