

## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOK CHEUNG STREET AND  
FUK CHAK STREET, TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulation, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (I) *From about 10.00 a.m. on 16 May 2022 to about 10.00 a.m. on 4 June 2022*
- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Fuk Chak Street to a point about 65 metres north of the same junction;
  - (b) the western kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Fuk Chak Street to a point of about 55 metres north of the same junction; and
  - (c) the section of Fuk Chak Street from its junction with Kok Cheung Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.
- (II) *From about 10.00 a.m. on 4 June 2022 to about 6.00 p.m. on 23 July 2022*
- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Li Tak Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction;
  - (b) the western kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Li Tak Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction; and
  - (c) the section of Fuk Chak Street from its junction with Kok Cheung Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
