ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KWAI FONG STREET AND CHUN SHING STREET, HAPPY VALLEY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 17 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Kwai Fong Street from its junction with Chun Shing Street to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Kwai Fong Street from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Chun Shing Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the eastern and western kerbside lane of Chun Shing Street from its junction with Kwai Fong Street to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner of Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
