ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON VILLAGE ROAD, WANG TAK STREET AND PO SHIN STREET. HAPPY VALLEY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 17 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Village Road from its junction with Wang Tak Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Wang Tak Street from its junction with Village Road to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Wang Tak Street from its junction with Po Shin Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Po Shin Street from its junction with Wang Tak Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner of Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
