

ESTATE AGENTS ORDINANCE (Chapter 511)

Pursuant to section 30 of the Estate Agents Ordinance, it is hereby notified that the Disciplinary Committee of Estate Agents Authority has exercised the following disciplinary power against the following licensee:—

<i>Matter Concerned</i>	The licensee, in handling a tenancy transaction of a residential property concerned ('the Property'): <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) failed to arrange all the co-owners of the Property to enter into the provisional tenancy agreement; and</li><li>(ii) failed to arrange all the co-owners of the Property to enter into the tenancy agreement.</li></ul>

<i>Decision on Disciplinary Power Exercised</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In respect of the aforesaid matter (i):—<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) The licensee is reprimanded; and</li><li>(b) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.</li></ul></li><li>2. In respect of the aforesaid matter (ii):—<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) The licensee is reprimanded; and</li><li>(b) A condition is attached to the licensee's licence requiring the licensee to attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority within 12 months, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.</li></ul></li></ul>

With regard to paragraphs 1(b) and 2(b) above, the Disciplinary Committee, having regard to the principle of totality, decided that the following condition is attached to the licence concerned of the licensee:—

'The above-named licensee shall, during the period of 12 months from 17 April 2023 to 16 April 2024, attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme 'Compliance and Effective Management' category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority, and at least 3 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.'
