

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TAI KOK TSUI ROAD AND ANCHOR STREET,  
TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulation, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 January 2023, the following road sections in Tai Kok Tsui will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Tai Kok Tsui Road from its junction with Anchor Street to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Anchor Street from its junction with Tai Kok Tsui Road to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Tai Kok Tsui Road from its junction with Li Tak Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
