ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT YUE MAN SQUARE PUBLIC TRANSPORT INTERCHANGE. KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 20 May 2022, the following road sections in Kwun Tong will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of the carriageway leading to the exit of Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange from a point about 55 metres west of its junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 75 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside of the carriageway leading to the exit of Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange from a point about 80 metres west of its junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 95 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside of the carriageway leading to the exit of Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange from a point about 80 metres west of its junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the eastern kerbside of the carriageway leading to the exit of Yue Man Square Public Transport Interchange from a point about 105 metres west of its junction with Hip Wo Street to a point about 120 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
