ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CASTLE PEAK ROAD—CASTLE PEAK BAY AND TSING HOL CIRCUIT IN TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 20 May 2022 (Friday), the following road sections in Tuen Mun will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern and northern kerbside lanes of Tsing Hoi Circuit eastbound from a point about 25 metres west of its junction with Castle Peak Road—Castle Peak Bay to the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road—Castle Peak Bay northbound from a point about 10 metres south of its southern junction with Tsing Hoi Circuit to the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Castle Peak Road—Castle Peak Bay northbound from its southern junction with Tsing Hoi Circuit to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
