

**L.N. 78 of 2022**

**Marine Fish Culture (Amendment) Regulation 2022**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 22 of the Marine Fish Culture Ordinance (Cap. 353))

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation comes into operation on 1 October 2022.

**2. Marine Fish Culture Regulations amended**

The Marine Fish Culture Regulations (Cap. 353 sub. leg. A) are amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.

**3. Regulation 10C repealed (no fee payable for grant or renewal of licence between October 2021 and September 2022)**

Regulation 10C—

**Repeal the regulation.**

**4. Regulation 10D added**

Before regulation 11—

**Add**

**“10D. No fee payable for grant or renewal of licence between October 2022 and September 2023**

- (1) Despite regulation 10(1), no fee is payable for the grant or renewal of a licence if the licence so granted or renewed takes effect within the period from 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023 (both dates inclusive).

### **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Marine Fish Culture Regulations (Cap. 353 sub. leg. A) (*principal Regulations*) to extend the concession introduced by the Marine Fish Culture (Amendment) Regulation 2021 (L.N. 183 of 2021) so that no fee is payable for the grant or renewal of a licence to engage in fish culture within a fish culture zone that takes effect within the period from October 2022 to September 2023.

2. This Regulation also repeals regulation 10C of the principal Regulations. That provision expires when this Regulation comes into operation.
