**Public Health (Animals and Birds) (Licensing of
Livestock Keeping) (Amendment) Regulation 2022**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 3 of the Public Health (Animals and Birds) Ordinance (Cap. 139))

1. Commencement

Explanatory Note

The Public Health (Animals and Birds) (Licensing of Livestock Keeping) (Amendment) Regulation 2021 (L.N. 184 of 2021) amended the Public Health (Animals and Birds) (Licensing of Livestock Keeping) Regulation (Cap. 139 sub. leg. L) (*principal Regulation*) to prescribe a lower fee for the renewal, within the concession period from 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022, of a licence to keep livestock in or on premises in respect of which the licence is granted within a livestock waste restriction area or a livestock waste control area.

2. This Regulation amends the principal Regulation to extend the concession period for another year (1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023).
