**Dangerous Goods (Government Explosives Depots)
(Amendment) Regulation 2022**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 13E of the
Dangerous Goods Ordinance (Cap. 295))

1. Commencement

This Regulation comes into operation on 1 October 2022.

**2. Dangerous Goods (Government Explosives Depots) Regulations
amended**

The Dangerous Goods (Government Explosives Depots) Regulations (Cap. 295 sub. leg. D) are amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.

**3. Regulation 13C repealed (storage fees and delivery fees not
payable between October 2021 and September 2022)**

Regulation 13C—

Repeal the regulation.

4. Regulation 13D added

Before regulation 14—

Add

**“13D. Storage fees and delivery fees not payable between October
2022 and September 2023**

- (1) Regulation 12 does not apply in relation to storage during the period from 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023 (both dates inclusive).

- (2) Regulation 13 does not apply in relation to delivery during the period from 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023 (both dates inclusive).
- (3) This regulation expires at midnight on 30 September 2023.”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Dangerous Goods (Government Explosives Depots) Regulations (Cap. 295 sub. leg. D) (*principal Regulations*) to extend the concessions introduced by the Dangerous Goods (Government Explosives Depots) (Amendment) Regulation 2021 (L.N. 192 of 2021) so that no fee is payable for—

- (a) the storage of explosives and explosive accessories in a Government Explosives Depot during the period from 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023 (*concession period*); and
 - (b) the delivery of explosives and explosive accessories from a Government Explosives Depot to another place by the Government during the concession period.
2. This Regulation also repeals regulation 13C of the principal Regulations. That provision expires when this Regulation comes into operation.
