Electricity (Registration) (Amendment) Regulation 2022

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 59 of the Electricity Ordinance (Cap. 406) and section 29 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1))

1. Commencement

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Regulation comes into operation on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.
- (2) Section 3(1) comes into operation on 1 October 2022.

2. Electricity (Registration) Regulations amended

The Electricity (Registration) Regulations (Cap. 406 sub. leg. D) are amended as set out in section 3.

Explanatory Note

Regulation 13A of the Electricity (Registration) Regulations (Cap. 406 sub. leg. D) provides for concessions on the application fees and renewal fees in relation to the following matters if the applications for the matters are received during the period from 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022 (*concession period*)—

- (a) a registration, or a renewal of registration, as an electrical contractor;
- (b) a registration, or a renewal of registration, as an electrical worker.

2. This Regulation amends that regulation 13A to extend the concession period for another year (1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023).
