

ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON TATE'S CAIRN HIGHWAY
AND SHA LEK HIGHWAY, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. of the following day daily from Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays) during the period from 30 May 2022 to 10 June 2022, the following road sections will be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of the slip road of Tate's Cairn Highway southbound from a point about 50 metres south of its junction with Shek Mun Interchange to a point about 250 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Tate's Cairn Highway southbound from a point about 250 metres south of its junction with Shek Mun Interchange to a point about 160 metres south of its junction with Sha Lek Highway southbound; and
- (c) the section of Sha Lek Highway southbound from its junction with Tate's Cairn Highway southbound to a point about 300 metres south of the same junction.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
