ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of access road leading from Chun Shek Bus Terminus to Fung Shek Street from its junction with Fung Shek Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction:
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Shing Tin Street from its junction with Fung Shek Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Shing Tin Street from a point about 5 metres west of its junction with Fung Shek Street to a point about 50 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the section of access road leading from Chui Tin Street to Sun Chui Estate from its junction with Chui Tin Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Chui Tin Street from a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Kak Tin Street to a point about 85 metres west of the same junction; and
- (f) the northern kerbside lane of Chui Tin Street from a point about 55 metres west of its junction with Kak Tin Street to a point about 105 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
