ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT SHA KOK STREET, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Sha Kok Street from its junction with access road leading to Tsang Tai Uk New Village to a point about 24 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of access road leading to Tsang Tai Uk New Village from its junction with Sha Kok Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of access road leading to Tsang Tai Uk New Village from a point about 14 metres south of its junction with Sha Kok Street to a point about 27 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
