

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON SPRING GARDEN LANE AND JOHNSTON ROAD,
WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Spring Garden Lane from its junction with Cross Street to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Spring Garden Lane from its junction with Cross Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Spring Garden Lane from its junction with Johnston Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Spring Garden Lane from its junction with Johnston Road to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Johnston Road from its junction with Spring Garden Lane to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction; and
- (f) the southern kerbside lane of Johnston Road from its junction with Spring Garden Lane to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner of Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
