ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN PUBLIC SQUARE STREET, YAU MA TEI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulation, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 June 2022 to 31 July 2022, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Ching Ping Street from its junction with Public Square Street to a point about 40 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Ching Ping Street from its junction with Public Square Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Public Square Street from its junction with Ching Ping Street to a point about 50 metres east of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Public Square Street from its junction with Ching Ping Street to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
