ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN SOUTHERN DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 27 May 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Cyberport Road from a point about 20 metres south of lamp post number 46846 to a point about 23 metres south of the same lamp post;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Cyberport Road from a point about 25 metres north of lamp post number 46842 to a point about 30 metres north of the same lamp post;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of unnamed road near Cyberport Road from a point about 11 metres west of lamp post number 46877 to a point about 11 metres east of the same lamp post; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of unnamed road near Cyberport Road from a point about 11 metres west of lamp post number 46877 to a point about 10 metres east of the same lamp post.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
