

PROVISION OF FOOD WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES—NEW TERRITORIES

It is hereby notified that sealed tender is invited for the following contracts:—

The service scope comprises provision of collection services of source separated food waste from Food Waste Collection Points (FWCPs) to the O•PARK 1 at 5 Sham Fung Road, Siu Ho Wan, North Lantau Island, N.T. (or other Government facilities) for treatment. The services are expected to commence in January 2023 and the contract period is two (2) years.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Government Logistics Department, and placed in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated at Lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on Friday, 22 July 2022. Tender must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice ('Specified Tender Box') before the tender closing time. Late tender or tender not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted.

If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is issued, or a black rainstorm warning signal or 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on Friday, 22 July 2022, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is cancelled, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions after super typhoons' announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on Friday, 22 July 2022, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable.
