ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LUNG SUM AVENUE AND UNNAMED ACCESS ROADS OF THE VEHICULAR EXITS OF SHEUNG SHUI BUS TERMINUS. SHEUNG SHUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 2 June 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Lung Sum Avenue from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with the Landmark North carpark vehicular exit to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of unnamed access road of Sheung Shui Bus Terminus northern vehicular exit from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of unnamed access road of Sheung Shui Bus Terminus northern vehicular exit from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of unnamed access road of Sheung Shui Bus Terminus southern vehicular exit from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of unnamed access road of Sheung Shui Bus Terminus southern vehicular exit from its junction with Lung Sum Avenue to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Lung Sum Avenue from its junction with Sheung Shui Bus Terminus southern vehicular exit to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction; and
- (g) the eastern kerbside lane of Lung Sum Avenue from its junction with Sheung Shui Bus Terminus southern vehicular exit to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
