# SCALE OF FARES NOTICE LONG WIN BUS COMPANY LIMITED

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) of the Public Bus Services Ordinance (Chapter 230) ('the Ordinance'), the Chief Executive in Council has determined a new scale of fares for carriage of passengers specified in Part I of the Schedule to take effect on 18 June 2023. The new scale of fares, the concessionary fares in Part II of the Schedule, and the maximum rate of increase which may be permitted by the Commissioner for Transport under the Ordinance as stipulated in Part III of the Schedule are published for general information.

## 2. Concessionary Fares

- (a) Children below the age of 12 years shall be charged on every service one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.
- (b) Children below the age of 4 years, if accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, shall be carried free of charge. Not more than two children shall be carried free of charge by any one adult.
- (c) Passengers aged 65 or above shall be charged on every service one half of the adult single fare for any journey calculated to the nearest ten cents above.

- 3. The maximum rate of increase is 50% of the scale of fares specified in Part I.
- 4. The scale of fares gazetted in the Schedule to G.N. 2593 of 2011 is hereby superseded.
