

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PING TIN STREET AND ON TIN STREET, LAM TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 June 2023, the following road sections in Lam Tin will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Ping Tin Street from its eastern junction with On Tin Street to a point about 170 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Ping Tin Street from its eastern junction with On Tin Street to a point about 120 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of On Tin Street from its eastern junction with Ping Tin Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of On Tin Street from its eastern junction with Ping Tin Street to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
