ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON MAN KAM TO ROAD AND SHA LING ROAD, NORTH DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 June 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Man Kam To Road northbound from a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Sha Ling Road to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Sha Ling Road from its junction with Man Kam To Road to a point about 165 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the section of the unnamed access road connecting Sha Ling Road northbound from its junction with Sha Ling Road to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of the unnamed access road connecting Sha Ling Road southbound from its junction with Sha Ling Road to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
