

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT LOK SHUN PATH, FO TAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 23 June 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Lok Shun Path from a point about 144 metres north of its junction with Lok King Street to a point about 150 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Lok Shun Path from a point about 167 metres north of its junction with Lok King Street to a point about 174 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
